Project Objectives

- > Provide residents, students and workers a **premium way** to connect between the San Gabriel and San Fernando Valleys
 - **Improved bus service and reliability** (*BRT offers more frequent service & shorter travel times*)
 - Connect people with **major destinations** and **employment centers**
- > Enhanced connectivity to Metro's A, B and G Lines and other regional transit
- > Provide improved passenger comfort and convenience
 - **All-door boarding**
 - **Enhanced bus stations**
 - **Dedicated bus lanes**



Project Schedule Update

- Design Submittal Schedule
 - > 100% design in Pasadena & Burbank
 - > 85% in NoHo, Glendale and Eagle Rock
 - 100% Spring 2026
- **Construction set to begin in Pasadena in April 2026**
 - Corridor wide construction begins by summer 2026
- Construction complete by end 2027. Open for revenue service ahead of 2028 Olympic Games
- **Metro Eat Shop** play engaging impacted businesses
